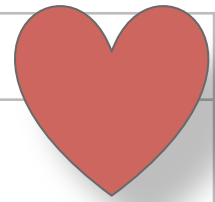

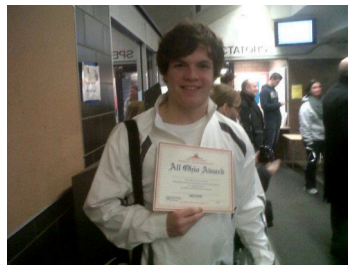
## ROCKY RIVER, OH:

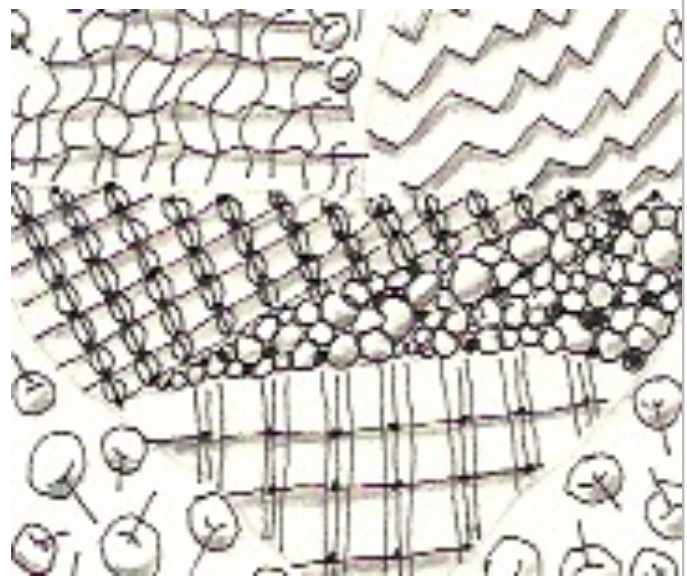
## THE BIG DAY
