and the kids need to get out and play!

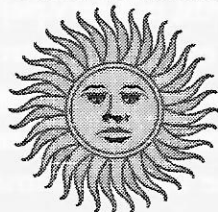
So get yourselves ready to celebrate

"OOPS"

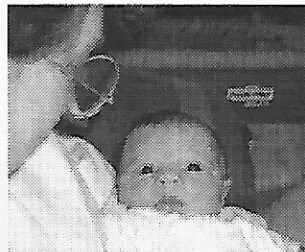
