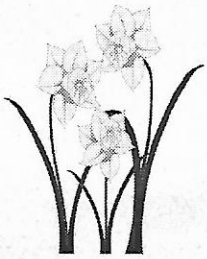

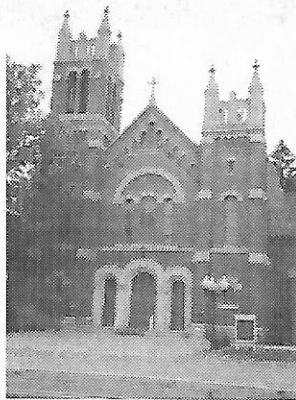
A special thanks to the two of you, Hank and Richard, for your special interest in this project and for mounting it so handsomely.

God bless you all and, at least belatedly, "Happy Thanksgiving."

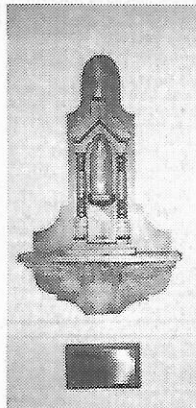

Pink/ruby grapefruit supply 100 times more beta-carotene than white grapefruit.

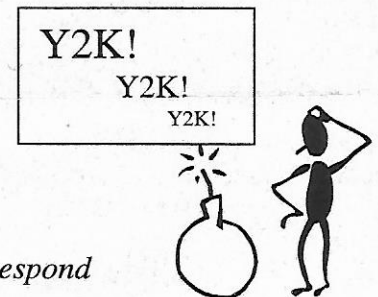
- Did you know that it takes forty gallons of maple sap to get one gallon of maple syrup?
