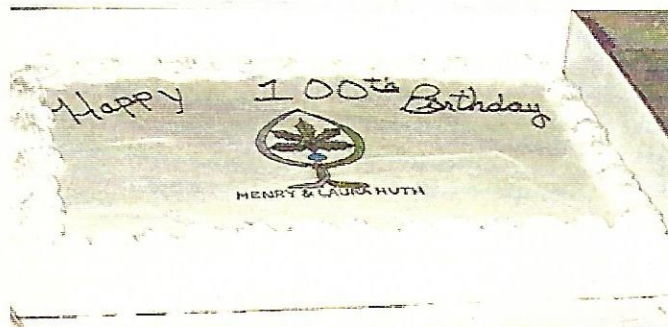




Summer Recap

Don't forget, those letters, visits, phone calls and prayers do make a difference.

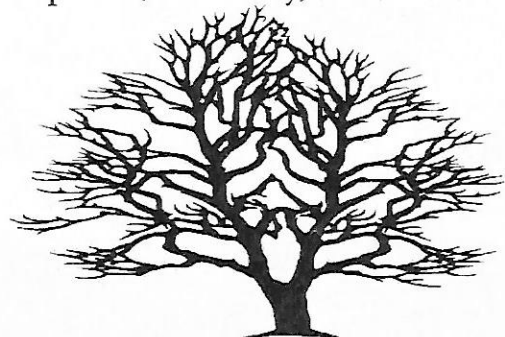
Historic Notes

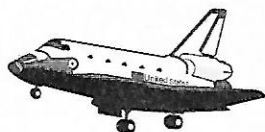
In The News
